As of the most recent available data (**February 03, 2025**), **4.0% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **6.5% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **5.4% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes **6.5% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (February 03, 2025), 28.5% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 27.3% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 27.4% more graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 27.3% more credits.
