2020-21 Recent Graduate Survey Summary of Findings

Executive Summary

The Recent Graduate Survey was administered by the Brooklyn College Office of Institutional Effectiveness to 4,294 students who completed a degree at Brooklyn College during the 2020-21 academic year. The survey launched on October 21, 2021, and continued until July 8, 2022. 867 students, or 20.2% of those contacted, completed a survey.

- 1) 79.2% of our recent baccalaureate recipients, and 45.8% of our recent graduate degree recipients, intend to apply for further education.
- 2) 59.1% of recent baccalaureate recipients who intended to pursue further education indicated that their next degree would be a master's degree other than an MBA, while 11.5% expressed an interest in pursuing an MBA.
- 3) 28.6% of recent baccalaureate recipients, and 31.4% of graduate degree recipients, indicated that they had an internship while a student at Brooklyn College.
 - a. Of undergraduates who had an internship, 46.6% reported having at least one that was paid. 50.0% of graduates reported the same.
 - b. Of undergraduates who had an internship, 71.4% reported having at least one that was unpaid. 64.8% of graduates reported the same.
- 4) 70.4% of our recent baccalaureate recipients, and 87.5% of our recent graduate degree recipients, reported that they had an internship that was moderately or strongly related to their career.
- 5) 30.7% of our recent baccalaureate recipients, and 54.2% of our recent graduate degree recipients, reported having at least one full-time job while at Brooklyn College.
- 6) 41.3% of our recent baccalaureate recipients, and 26.7% of our recent graduate degree recipients, reported utilizing the Magner Center while at Brooklyn College.
- 7) 23.0% of respondents who did not use the Magner Center said they were not aware that it existed.
- 8) 64.9% of our recent graduates who had used the Magner Center said it was somewhat or very helpful in finding an internship.
- 9) 57.9% of our recent graduates who had used the Magner Center said it was somewhat or very helpful in finding a career-track job.
- 10) 72.8% of our recent baccalaureate recipients, and 89.4% of our recent graduate degree recipients, were employed at the time of the survey.
 - a. 52.9% of recent baccalaureate recipients indicated that their job was full-time
 - b. 17.4% of recent baccalaureate recipients indicated that had employees that reported to them.
 - c. 60.8% of recent baccalaureate recipients indicated that this job was a career-track position.
- 11) Baccalaureate recipients (55.1%) who were employed were most often employed by a private business, while graduate degree recipients (52.1%) were most often employed by the government or other public employers.
- 12) The median salary for recent baccalaureate recipients was in the range of \$40,000 to \$49,999. For graduate degree recipients, it was in the range of \$60,000 to \$69,999.
- 13) 52.6% of our recent baccalaureate recipients, and 82.8% of our recent graduate degree recipients, reported that their job was moderately or strongly related to their Brooklyn College major.

- 14) 31.2% of our recent baccalaureate recipients, and 61.7% of our recent graduate degree recipients, indicated that Brooklyn College had prepared them very well, or extremely well, for their current job.
- 15) Recent graduates were given a list of five general student learning outcomes for Brooklyn College students.
 - a. Recent baccalaureate recipients were most positive about how Brooklyn College had prepared them to integrate knowledge from diverse sources. 58.2% said that Brooklyn College had done so very well or extremely well.
 - b. Recent graduate degree recipients were most positive about how Brooklyn College had prepared them to think critically and creatively. 72.0% said that Brooklyn College had done so very well or extremely well.
- 16) 51.1% of our recent baccalaureate recipients, and 61.8% of our recent graduate degree recipients, said they would recommend Brooklyn College to someone like themselves without reservations.
- 17) 63.7% of our recent baccalaureate recipients, and 74.8% of our recent graduate degree recipients, described the academic reputation of Brooklyn College as strong or very strong.
