2021-22 Recent Graduate Survey Summary of Findings

#### **Executive Summary**

The Recent Graduate Survey was administered by the Brooklyn College Office of Institutional Effectiveness to 4,077 students who completed a degree at Brooklyn College during the 2021-22 academic year. The survey launched on May 9, 2022, and continued until April 2, 2023. 1,094 students, or 37.5% of those contacted, completed a survey.


- 1) 76.0% of our recent undergraduate degree recipients, and 52.1% of our recent graduate degree recipients, intend to apply for further education
- 2) 59.0% of recent undergraduate degree recipients who intended to pursue further education indicated that their next degree would be a master's degree other than an MBA, while 13.2% expressed an interest in pursuing an MBA.
- 3) 26.0% of recent undergraduate degree recipients, and 25.5% of graduate degree recipients, indicated that they had an internship while a student at Brooklyn College.
  - a. Of undergraduates who had an internship, 56.7% reported that this was a paid internship or internship that led to employment. 45.4% of graduates reported the same.
- 4) 69.5% of our recent undergraduate degree recipients, and 77.3% of our recent graduate degree recipients, reported having a job while at Brooklyn College.
- 5) 33.1% of our recent undergraduate degree recipients, and 17.8% of our recent graduate degree recipients, reported utilizing the Magner Center while at Brooklyn College.
- 6) 64.9% of our recent undergraduate degree recipients, and 85.1% of our recent graduate degree recipients, were employed at the time of the survey.
  - a. 40.8% of recent undergraduate degree recipients indicated that their job was full-time
  - b. 23.7% of recent undergraduate degree recipients indicated that had employees that reported to them.
  - c. 60.7% of recent undergraduate degree recipients indicated that this job was a career-track position.
- 7) Baccalaureate recipients (61.3%) who were employed were most often employed by a private business, while graduate degree recipients (50.6%) were most often employed by the government or other public employers.
- 8) The median salary for recent undergraduate degree recipients was in the range of \$30,000 to \$39,999. For graduate degree recipients, it was in the range of \$60,000 to \$69,999.
- 9) 55.2% of our recent undergraduate degree recipients, and 81.9% of our recent graduate degree recipients, reported that their job was moderately or strongly related to their Brooklyn College major.
- 10) 33.9% of our recent undergraduate degree recipients, and 53.9% of our recent graduate degree recipients, indicated that Brooklyn College had prepared them very well, or extremely well, for their current job.
- 11) Recent graduates were given a list of five general student learning outcomes for Brooklyn College students.
  - a. Recent undergraduate degree recipients were most positive about how Brooklyn College had prepared them to integrate knowledge from diverse sources. 63.3% said that Brooklyn College had done so very well or extremely well.

- b. Recent graduate degree recipients were most positive about how Brooklyn College had prepared them to think critically and creatively. 56.5% said that Brooklyn College had done so very well or extremely well.
- 12) 50.4% of our recent undergraduate degree recipients, and 58.1% of our recent graduate degree recipients, said they would recommend Brooklyn College to someone like themselves without reservations.
- 13) 64.9% of our recent undergraduate degree recipients, and 75.2% of our recent graduate degree recipients, described the academic reputation of Brooklyn College as strong or very strong.

NOTE. This survey report contains three sections: responses by all respondents; responses by those with undergraduate degrees (Bachelor's or Undergraduate Certificate), and responses by those with graduate degrees (Master's or Advanced Certificate/Diploma). This survey report only provides results for closed-ended items.




#### What is the next degree you intend to pursue? - Selected Choice


#### When are you planning to pursue the degree?














# How do you see you current job, relative to your career?

# How closely related is your job to your major at BC?













### How would you describe the academic reputation of Brooklyn College?



# On average in a semester, what was the number of times were you asked to complete a survey at Brooklyn College? Please respond with a number







# Which best describes how you started your education at Brooklyn College for the degree you are graduating with? - Selected Choice

















# How closely related is your job to your major at BC?







## How likely are you to recommend Brooklyn College to someone?



## How would you describe the academic reputation of Brooklyn College?



# On average in a semester, what was the number of times were you asked to complete a survey at Brooklyn College? Please respond with a number






















