

Undergraduate Final Examination Schedule Spring 2016

Final examinations for the **Spring 2016** semester will be held from **Friday, May 20, through Friday, May 27**. Final examinations have been scheduled based on uniform examinations (in the bold print below) and the section of the course. A copy of the complete undergraduate final examination schedule appears in the table below. **Conflict examinations will not be scheduled; therefore, programs with courses whose final examinations are held at the same time should not be requested.**
